From the Pastor's Desk

"As surely as I live, declares the Sovereign Lord, I take no pleasure in the death of the wicked but rather that they turn from their ways and live. Turn!" - Ezekiel 33:11

For most of 2014, I have been encouraging you to learn how to say "No". None of us is God which means that none of us can do it all. None of us can meet every demand that is placed on our lives. As odd as it may sound, I have been pleased to hear "No" coming from a few surprising places. Redeemer members have shared with me stories of making the difficult (but necessary) choice to put up good boundaries. I had to eat my own words when a ministry committee shot down an idea I had. Why? Because they needed to say "No". I am proud of them - it was not easy, but following Christ faithfully is not easy. Having said that, I hope everyone

"No" is to focus on God's *"Yes"*. No one wants to be around a naysayer. The book of Ezekiel makes this clear. After pronouncing impending doom and watching his hometown of Jerusalem get destroyed, Ezekiel does an about-face. He starts to proclaim a vibrant future. After years of *"No"*, Ezekiel closes out his calling as a prophet by giving us some of the most **beautiful images of God's brilliant** future. I will be preaching through these passages in August.

After spending half of the year on *"No"*, we will now begin the transition to God's *"Yes!"*. God makes it clear that the only reason He says *"No"* is to point up

to point us toward something better. His heart is that they live.



What is God's "Yes" for your life? What are His purposes for you? What is He calling you to do? Having spent half of the year learning about "No", I hope you will take the time to seek out God's "Yes".

Renovate Update

Note: This update was written on July 17th – things may have changed since then. Current updates are located in the foyer.

Thanks everyone for your patience and support of our Renovate campaign. As you can all see, the concrete foundation for a new marguee sign

along Frankford Road has begun. Here's what will take place over the next few weeks:

- The new sign will be completed masonry and electrical.
- The old sign will be demolished. (Pastor Mark's note Yay!)
- The flower bed on the east side of our driveway (the right hand side as you leave Redeemer) will be removed. This flower bed currently blocks our new sign.

Once the sign is completed, we will look to add some landscaping this Fall. The landscaping will consist of irrigation and trees along Frankford and McCoy Road as well as landscaping on the north side of our building.

For those wondering, after the sign is completed we expect to have between \$8,000 to \$10,000 left toward our initial Renovate fund. In addition, we have also designated \$30,000 of our \$100,000 gift towards Renovate. We are in the process of receiving quotes now for the next phase.

Pray that the work on our sign goes safely and smoothly, that we have a successful fall planting for our landscape, and that we get accurate quotes for the next phase of the Renovate Project.

Land Deal Update

Note: This update was written on July 17th. *Current updates are located in the foyer.*

On July 9th we officially signed a contract to sell a portion of our land to a developer who will use the land to build homes. The land we want to sell is 3.5 of our 7.1 acres. It is the southern half of our land. As some have been confused I will reiterate – we are keeping the intersection of McCoy and Frankford.

The advantage for us it that we can use land that isn't valuable to us to pay down a significant portion of our mortgage with the proceeds of the land.

We were able to negotiate an acceptable price with the developer. In addition, the developer agreed to move

Harvest Community Garden to a new place on our property and to put up a mason fence and tree line separating the two properties at their expense. While all of these are exciting developments, this

While all of these are exciting developments, this deal is still in the baby-stages and could fall apart. The developer will be doing surveys and soil tests and may back out if he finds any obstacles to his

plans. After that, both the City of Carrollton and CFB-ISD will have their say - either of whom may say no and kill the deal immediately. This is far from a done deal.

Pray for good results from the survey and for favor with the city council, CFB-ISD, and the planning/zoning commission. Pray for God's will to be done in this deal.


