## From the Pastor's Desk

*"Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body also will rest secure." (Psalm 16:9)*

After nearly 8 years of ministry at Redeemer, I am looking forward to using the month of June to recharge my batteries and re-focus on Jesus Christ. Redeemer's Executive Committee has graciously agreed to give me a one month sabbatical in June. It will begin June 8<sup>th</sup> and go to July 8<sup>th</sup>.

What is a sabbatical? It is an intentional time away from ministry in order to do two things: First, I will focus on rest. This has been a year of important distractions. Plenty of my time in the past 18 months has been taken up with the land deal, Renovate, and seeking financial stability at Redeemer (switching to a bookkeeper). 


## Update on Our Land Deal


# Gear Up for a VBS Expedition!

Our 5 day Everest expedition begins at Redeemer Church on Monday, July 6 and ends with our Summit celebration on Friday, July 10.

If you would like to bless the children of our church as well as the surrounding mountains, please sign up!

These are the different stations where leaders and volunteers will be needed:

- ☞ Registration - make name tags, keep track of attendance, and register new kids
- ☞ Publicity - distribute flyers, registration forms, and printed materials
- ☞ Preschool Peak - work with our little preschoolers in their own environment
- ☞ Base Camp Sing & Play - learn the 10 songs and their motions, lead the singing and opening activities, summarize the daily Bible story, and share the excitement as kids report their daily God Sightings
- ☞ Bible Expeditions - set up the room each day, and lead kids through fun hands-on learning activities that make the Bible story come alive
- ☞ Imagination Station - set up (3 days), demonstrate, and help kids experiment with their gizmos, and help them connect the fun experiments to the truths in the daily Bible verse
- ☞ Glacier Games - set up games and lead the Crews in creative games
- ☞ KidVid Cinema - set up and run films about real kids living out their faith in cool ways



- ☞ Mountaintop Treats - gather supplies; make, serve, and clean up the daily snack that connects with the Bible verse
- ☞ Expedition Crew Leaders - arrive a little early, energetically take your Climbing Crew through the activities, and lead them in small group discussions and prayers
- ☞ Summit Celebration - collect supplies and props, use drama experiences and engaging object lessons to help kids apply what they have learned, and enthusiastically lead all the kids in the daily Finale
- ☞ Sound Booth Technician - run sound and microphones
- ☞ Media Technician - operate computer, **DVD's for music and Chadder video**, and run the Spotlight VBS segment (on the large screen in the sanctuary)
- ☞ Spotlight VBS - gather props, take photos of the kids in specific poses, use the Spotlight VBS CD to create a cool photo presentation on the big screen
- ☞ Hospitality Room - supply drinks and snacks for leaders and adult helpers, set up, and clean up each day
- ☞ Decorating - help create a majestic mountain terrain throughout our church. There will be plenty of time options to help

# Midsouth Covenant Summer Camp for Kids!

August 2-8, 2012



Midsouth Covenant Camp is a summer camp organized by the Midsouth Conference of the Evangelical Covenant Church and

located in Grapeland, TX, where we rent Frontier Camp. ([www.frontiercamp.org](http://www.frontiercamp.org))

The primary goal of the camp is to show each camper the love, knowledge, and saving power of Jesus Christ.

Students entering grades 2—9 will enjoy programs tailored to their age (grouped by grade levels 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>/ 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>).

Activities include a wide variety of water activities, riflery, archery, volleyball, basketball, rope swing, horseback riding, climbing wall, skate park, and crafts.

The theme will be “Bullies of the Bible” which will feature stories highlighting Biblical aspects of why people are bullies, how God can heal bullies, how God wants us to deal with bullies, and how God cares for us as victims of bullies. We will study these Bible stories that demonstrate bullying: Cain, Samson, Joseph’s brothers, and Saul of Tarsus. Saul’s Damascus Road experience is an illustration that “you have received the light” and how a bully’s heart and behavior is changed.

**Camp Costs:** The 2015 camp registration fee is \$465. All registration forms must include a \$50 deposit to reserve a place for each camper, and can be submitted by mail, FAX, or scan.

**Early Bird Discount  
Deadline is June 15**

Save money with Early Registration! Early registration is \$415 (when the \$50 deposit and completed registration forms are postmarked by June 15). Campers who register by July 15 will receive a t-shirt upon arrival at camp. Additional t-shirts may be ordered for \$10 each. A waiting list will be kept for registrations received after cabins are full. All camp balances are due by August 2, 2015. Payments can also be made online at [www.midsouthcov.org](http://www.midsouthcov.org).



**Counselors in Leadership Training (CILT) Program** is a learning track for qualified high school students who have an interest in developing leadership skills and becoming camp counselors. They attend special CILT training sessions while at camp and participate in regular cabin and camp activities where they get “hands on” training experience. Applications are due by June 1 and upon acceptance into the CILT program, CILTs register as a camper.



Camper registration and deposit due June 15. CILT registration cost is \$375.

**Counseling Staff** is primarily made up of trained volunteers from Covenant churches in the Midsouth Conference. All staff members attend a training session for instruction about the camp’s purpose and procedures, as well

as general counseling techniques. Parents often volunteer as counselors while their own children attend camp.

## Important Dates:

June 1 = deadline for CILT applications

June 15 = deadline for Early Registration, \$50 deposit and registration forms due to the Midsouth office

= **deadline for CILT’s** camper registration and deposit

July 15 = all camp paperwork is due at the Midsouth office.

All T-shirt orders must be received by the Midsouth office. (New campers only accepted as space permits after this date.)

August 2 = all camp fees must be paid in full at camp check-in. Camp check-in is from 3-5 P.M.

August 9 = Camp ends with closing program/brunch
