From the Pastor's Desk

Arise, for it is your task, and we are with you; be strong and do it. Ezra 10:4

"It's not you. It's me." This simple phrase has ended many romantic relationships. If we happen to be the ones speaking those words we think we are letting the other person down easy. If we are the ones hearing them, we know that they ring trite. Like George Constanza from the television show *Seinfeld*, we would much rather hear that the blame was on us rather than watch our relationships crumble and be unable to do anything about it. But what if we could re-purpose those words?

In the book of Ezra, Ezra the priest faced a daunting task. In order to restore the people of Israel to wholeness, he needed them to undertake a difficult action – separating from their foreign wives. Even though Ezra was the only one who could command this, he hesitated. It was not until the people challenged him to take on his God-given responsibility that he did it. In that same way, each of us has a God-given responsibility to live out what He has called us to do. While we can and will support each other, we cannot do this for each other.

This year at Redeemer, we are going to take a negative statement and turn it into a positive. Our theme for 2016 will **be "It's not you. It's me." But rather** than break-up with one another, we are going to use this phrase to challenge ourselves. We are going to stop trying to live our faith through others but instead experience the living God for

ourselves. The way I like to put it: What would it look like to be a church where no one is on their own, yet everyone takes ownership? How many spiritual gifts would be



discovered? How many new ministries might be launched? How many lives changed? But it won't start until each look in the mirror and let God work through us, rather than pass it along to someone else. It's not you. It's me. - Mark Mohrweis

Proposed Change to Our Constitution

One action at the Annual Meeting is to vote on a change to Redeemer's constitution. This change was first proposed at the June 2015 Annual Meeting and it has to do with our financial auditing procedure. Below is the current bylaw along with the proposed change. The Bylaws Article VII, Section 5:

"The accounts of Redeemer Evangelical Covenant Church of Dallas, Texas and its committees shall be audited annually by the auditors recommended by the executive committee and approved at the annual congregational business meeting."

Proposed change:

"The accounts of Redeemer Evangelical Covenant Church of Dallas, Texas shall be audited every four years by an external auditing service. The audit service shall be selected by the church council. The congregation shall be notified of the audit and the audited reports shall be

made available at the following congregational business *meeting.*"

Why the change? The simple version: We have not doing this. I (Mark) am not aware of any audits taking place at Redeemer for the past 8 years. It seems that finding a volunteer committee to do this has been difficult and therefore no audits have taken place. Not only that, there is skepticism (rightfully so) that a randomly pieced together committee would have the financial expertise to conduct an audit. The Church Council is proposing is that we hire professionals to do our auditing every four years. Our bookkeeper (who would not be doing the audit) recommends the four year time frame. While it costs more than a volunteer force, we believe the quality of the audit along with not needing to find volunteers every year will be worth it.
