From the Pastor's Desk

The Lord's message rang out from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia— your faith in God has become known everywhere. (1 Thessalonians 1:8)

The photo next to this article is a photo of the town of Patzicia, Guatemala. This past month, thirty of us from four ECC churches in Texas went to Patzicia for a mission trip. The photo was taken an early morning from the balcony of a home I stayed in. We had a wonderful trip, filled with children's ministry, construction, in-home visits to the elderly, and plenty of fútbol (soccer – we lost to the Guatemalans).

This trip to Guatemala was the 9th mission trip of my life. While each trip has been different, some similar patterns emerge from all of them. I find that after a mission trip I am usually physically tired but spiritually refreshed. Why is that? For one thing, having less distractions helps me focus on God. No phones, no e-mail, no television, no internet. That devotional time, which is so hard to come by here at home, was easy to find in Guatemala.

Another reason I am spiritually refreshed is from seeing people around the world worship God. What a joy it is to know someone thousands of miles away, in another language and of another culture, is going through Ephesians just like we are here at Redeemer. It reminds me that the

gospel is global in nature.

Finally, I'm always recharged because of the passion for God I see in those around the world. Sometimes I feel guilty because when you look at circumstances, you would think I would be the one who is passionate for God because I have received so much from Him.

Nonetheless, beyond the guilt trip is an opportunity for me to take circumstances for what they are. I am grateful to be around such dedicated Christians,



even if it is only for a week.

Since summer is a time of travel, I hope many of you experience the same refreshment. It may or may not be on a mission trip. Wherever it is, I hope you find God present and the opportunity to put some things down for a week or two gives you an opportunity to see Him. But I also want to plant a seed: Redeemer is looking at sending a team (teams?) to Haiti or even Guatemala in 2018. What do you think? Could God be calling you?

International Ministries (HIM). Not only do their missions closely align with Redeemer's vision, but their areas of focus fit in with all three priorities of **OUTreach** – developing, sending, and supporting servant leaders; being ambassadors of social justice and reconciliation; and caring for the sick and the poor.

ElevateHer International Ministries

www.elevateherinternational.org

Their Mission: Empowering women to heal from trauma and become instruments for healing, peace and hope through large and small group biblically based trauma and life skills training.

Overview: ElevateHer began in Haiti, the birthplace of founder, Dieula Previlon, who was inspired by women's stories and examples of resilience. With the support of her husband, Fresnel and her two dearest friends, Betty and Anide, Dieula launched ElevateHer in 2012 focusing on training in the areas of trauma, bible study methods and comprehension, and leadership



development. Today, up to 250 women show up for the large-group training conferences. Their small group leadership training is where the women learn to take their training to their homes, churches, work and community, to bring healing, restoration and hope.

What's Next: There are several opportunities for Redeemer to get involved with ElevateHer moving forward, both as a congregation and as individuals. Prayer, short term mission trips, volunteering stateside, and cohosting special events are just some of the ways to support the ministry. Many Redeemer women have already supported the ministry in the past by sowing purses and making gift bags for the women in Haiti. We want this partnership to continue to provide opportunities like this, plus more!

Hosean International Ministries (HIM)

Their Mission: Empowering Haitians with the gospel of Jesus Christ through education, life skills training and economic growth.

Overview: Hosean International Ministries (HIM Haiti) is a ministry by Haitians, for Haitians. It began in 1984 by Haitian National, Caleb Lucien with one purpose in mind: transform lives by pointing people to Jesus Christ through education, life skills training, and economic growth. Over the past 28 years, HIM Haiti has grown to a staff of 150 Haitians working together with international partnerships from America, Brazil, and Canada to bring hope and real help to the people of Haiti.



What's Next: Redeemer will be doing several things to start supporting HIM as a new partner. Because this is a new partner, we want to first give everyone an opportunity to learn more about the ministry and all the things it does. Financially, Redeemer will be supporting HIM with \$200 a month for 2017 (Over 95% of all donations are spent directly in Haiti helping the people in need). We also want to start planning for a mission trip in 2018. HIM offers several opportunities for short-term trips, be it construction projects, youth camps, VBS, and leadership conferences. Prayer, individual support, and stateside events are just a few other ways Redeemer will be able to get involved on this new journey with HIM.



Redeemer's **OUTreach** ministry is the merger of our Missions Committee and Evangelism/Outreach Committee.



The average cost for school supplies - backpack, crayons, paper, pencils, etc. - is \$662 for an elementary student and up to \$1489 for a high school student. For some families in our community, preparing for the start of a new school year is a major financial burden. Through Metrocrest Services' *Hearts and Soles* program each year, we are able to partner and to help over 200 students in Carrollton-Farmers Branch prepare for going back to school. Hearts and Soles helps students start school with a new pair of shoes. Having a new pair of shoes might sound trivial, but to a student it can mean walking into school with confidence and ready for a fresh start. For parents, it helps to ease the financial burden of sending a child back to school.

Here is how you can help:

- **Time** - Sign up to volunteer for the event and help students and families try on shoes.
- **Donate** - Make a donation to the event. \$3,000 will provide a new pair of shoes to 200 students.
- **Prayer** - Pray for the students as they start school to feel confident, be ready to learn, and to grow in the classroom.





Ours is the Midsouth Conference, which is headquartered in Tulsa, OK and made up of Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas. At its annual "Family Reunion" (business meeting) this year, our delegates were Lyn Hall and Lori Vriend. Here are some highlights:



It was such a joy to be able to represent Redeemer Church as a delegate at the 2017 Midsouth Annual meeting in McAllen. I learned so much about our denomination, the conference, and the Rio Grande Valley. There are many opportunities to serve God through the Midsouth Conference and many services that the conference provides for its members. I encourage everyone to take the time to visit www.midsouthcov.org to learn about these opportunities.



Although it was exciting to learn about our denomination, the greater opportunity was in getting to meet the people and learn the history of the ECC in the Rio Grande Valley and its expansion south of the border into Mexico.
