From the Pastor's Desk

"If we are 'out of our mind', as some say – it is for God" - 2 Corinthians 5:13

Is your life messy? I am not asking if things around your house are physically messy, although I'm sure some of us have to do some post-Christmas cleaning. No, I am asking if your life is messy in all areas. Are things not perfectly ordered in your spiritual life, or in your mental state, or in your life goals? If so, you are not alone. All of us are messy. The good news is the Bible will show us that God is present in the mess.

The theme at Redeemer for 2015 will be "God Bless This Mess." I decided on the theme early this fall when I heard a speaker discuss multi-ethnic churches. One of the things he said was if you are in a multi-ethnic church, just plan ahead to offend and to be offended by others. He said that multi-ethnic ministry is messy. That resounded with me and I decided to make it our 2015 theme. I hope the theme will give us the

courage to stick it out in relationships that are not easy, to try (and possibly fail) at new adventures, and to see that God can still use brokenness. Most importantly, I hope that people begin to understand there is no such thing as a perfect church. There is however, a

FORGIVING church. And the more we get used to "messes" in our lives, the more forgiving we will be.



I'll go a step further. Not only is God in the mess, I think sometimes God CAUSES the mess. The reason isn't that He wants to hurt or disappoint us but rather because it can be the mess that transforms us. So to kick off 2015, I challenge to look at your own life. No doubt it's not perfect. But do you have the courage to pray "God Bless this Mess?"


