From the Pastor's Desk

I am the vine; You are the branches. If you remain in Me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing. - John 15:5

What would you consider to be your greatest accomplishment? If you were put on the spot today, what would you say has been the high point of your life? No doubt some of us would highlight our careers. For others it would be academics. For others, our families. Maybe some of us would give the 'spiritual answer'. Many of us place great value on spiritual things. But do we really believe that our relationship with Christ is our greatest accomplishment?

For the sermons this spring we will be going through the Gospel of John. As we go through the gospel, we will be looking closely at John 15:5. Jesus says that the way to a fruitful life has little to do with your resume or your family or your talents. Rather, it has everything to do with your relationship with Him. There is nothing wrong with being grateful for your family or your resume or your talents. Nor is there anything wrong with utilizing your gifts for the Kingdom. But in terms of producing long-lasting impact, Jesus says the question to ask yourself is: Am I rooted in Him?

At Redeemer we have a year-long theme. The theme for 2016 is "It's not you, it's me." While you may

have heard that as a negative (someone breaking up with you!), I



hope for it to be a positive. My dream is that we could challenge ourselves to be a church where no one is on their own, but everyone takes ownership of what God has called them to do. We might have all sorts of feelings about what goals we have - or have not - accomplished. But the Bible says a simple choice to dwell with Christ will be the only solution for a fruitful life. I hope you are able to take ownership of that.
