# From the Pastor's Desk

Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. Psalm 96:1 We are in a season of change at Redeemer. Honestly, I am a guy that doesn't really like change. But the calling of Jesus Christ is always a balance – trusting that He is unchanging (Hebrews 13:8) while at that same time remembering that we are called to put new wine in new wineskins – or sing a new song. There are two major changes taking place at Redeemer that I hope you'll embrace and pray for as we undergo them.

First, many of you have already seen the changes in worship. After a meeting with the praise team in March, we identified some ways to grow in our worship. Our goal is to provide more freedom in worship and to make things feel less rushed and have more time for intentional prayer. To that extent, the worship songs are now in a block together (free from interruptions) and the greeting time is now after the service, instead of during. We have already noticed that we have more time to praise God and that Cassie is not yelling to get everyone back in their seats after the greeting. Second, coming this month, our **9:30** Sunday School will be on a summer hiatus. And I must be honest here -

there is a good chance it will not come back in the fall. Unfortunately our kids' ministry is non-existent at 9:30. I myself have been meeting with the High Schoolers while we search for a new youth pastor. Of my two students, one is graduating and I seriously doubt the other wants to be

the only student in Sunday School. Our adult coordinator has had a difficult time recruiting teachers for adult classes.



While this is tough and I know many of you have fond memories of Sunday school, my hope is that the goodbye to Sunday School will lead to growth in our small group ministry. I want to acknowledge change is difficult. Like I said, I am the first to admit I do not like it. But we must always be aware that we are on a journey. The journey means that the scenery, the road, and even the traveling companions will change from time to time. What I can say is that the destination will always remain the same: A closer walk with Jesus Christ and with one another.
