

Pumpkin Trifle Recipe

At our Thanksgiving Feast in November, 2016, Patricia Greer from Iglesia Emanuel brought a dessert that caused many people to ask about the recipe. Here it is:

Pumpkin Truffle -from the kitchen of Elaine Gestring

3 c. fat-free cold milk

2 small pkgs. sugar-free vanilla pudding

1 15-oz. canned pumpkin

3/4 tsp. ground cinnamon

1/2 tsp. ground nutmeg

1/4 tsp. ground ginger

1 2/3 c. gingersnap crumbs, roughly crushed

2 1/2 c. fat free Cool Whip (8-oz. container)



Mix together the milk, pudding, pumpkin, and spices.

- Ginger snaps
- Pumpkin mix with spices
- · Cool whip
