

# From the Pastor's Desk

God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.
(2 Corinthians 5:21)

Around this season, I am reminded of an encounter my wife and I had a few years back. To celebrate our first anniversary we traveled to the Dominican Republic for a week relaxing on the beach. It was everything you could ask for – the sounds of the ocean, the sand between your toes, good food, and no agenda except to enjoy life. It was a great week. While we had a great time, unfortunately Jessica

and I noticed something incredibly sad for others: While in paradise, we saw couples and families arguing the entire time they were on vacation.

Specifically, I remember traveling to the airport as we finished our vacation. We spoke with a man on our shuttle who was leaving the resort all by himself. Since we saw him come with a girlfriend earlier, we asked what happened. Apparently, his girlfriend broke up with him in the middle of their vacation and flew home immediately, leaving him at the resort all

by himself. While our hearts went out to this man, I did see a valuable lesson in his story. If we travel across the ocean to the fanciest resort we can find, with the most pristine beach, and the crystal clear swimming pool, there will still be brokenness. Even in paradise, sin is sin.

As humans, we are tempted to find hope and peace in many things: A beach vacation, a girlfriend or boyfriend, a new job or home, a goal or event, the government or a business. But ultimately, THE only source for our hope

and peace is Christ's death and resurrection. This month as we transition from Lent to Easter, it's a good time to reflect on where we place our hopes. Should it be anything

other than Christ, we may find ourselves thinking we are in paradise only to discover we are alone. But, if our hope is Christ, the promise of God's love and eternity is with us, and our brokenness is turned into righteousness. Truly, He has risen indeed!

# **Nursery Coordinator**


Redeemer has been blessed with a great nursery, loving care givers, and a history of outstanding nursery coordinators.






