From the Pastor's Desk

When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall *away.* (Mark 4:17)

36-32. I have spent some time pondering those numbers. That was the tally on one of our votes during the congregational meeting this past month. That figure stands out for how close it was. The vote for our \$100,000 in 2014 was 53 to 4. The vote for our land deal that same year was 48 to 2. The vote on calling me as your pastor in 2007 was 66 to 1. (Yes, I'm still on the hunt for the one guy who voted "no.")

But oddly enough, what would normally be a cause for concern has me fairly excited. Don't get me wrong - with a vote this close there is a very real danger of hurt feelings, lingering suspicions, and even resentment. But at the same time, I am convinced that much of what the church calls "unity" is actually superficiality. We "love" each other because we never challenge each other and certainly never rock the boat. Contrary to this, the Bible exhorts us to go deeper. True love and true community (koinonia) extends beyond the surface. It loves even when decisions are made that we disagree with.

I think it's important for our church to be unified, but we need to clarify what unity is and is not. Unity is NOT everyone conforming to the same opinion. For those that have strong feelings for or against the scholarship program we need

not change those opinions. (And to clarify – many were not against the scholarship idea, but felt strongly that a portion of the money needs to be given away before a scholarship program). Unity is making a commitment to understand another's perspective, even if you disagree. Unity is dealing with our hurts in healthy ways. For example, we confront those we are upset with rather than gossiping with our friends.

Two years ago I was on sabbatical. I visited one of the pre-eminent multiethnic churches in the United States and had lunch with



the pastor afterwards. His advice on multi-ethnic ministry? "If you are NOT being offended or offending someone, you are NOT doing it right". Like me, he was not a fan of conflict. But he also knew that a false sense of unity was even more dangerous than a genuine conflict.

I can live with 36-32 if it forces us to go deeper in our relationships with God and with each other. No one asks for persecution. No one wants to intentionally offend. But when these moments come, it is an opportunity to prove the genuineness of our faith. Let's see how genuine Redeemer is these next few months.

Congregational Meeting Report First, we welcomed some new council

Thanks to all who came and participated in our congregational meeting on June 4^{th} . It was a long meeting, but plenty of exciting steps took place!

- Gaylon Hull will switch from our Church Vice-Chair to our Treasurer.
- Elvis Obinma will become our new Church Vice-Chair.

- Elaine Petty will become our Church Secretary.
- Cynthia Northrop will become our Worship Chair.
- Chuck Dietrick will become our Facilities Chair.
- And of course, Tasha Moore signed on for another term as Evangelism Chair, which we are excited for!

Second, we approved two motions related to the gift of \$350,000.

- The first motion put \$100,000 into "Pressing Deferred Maintenance" at Redeemer. Projects include: Roof, Windows, Playground, Parking Lot, Doors.
- Also in the first motion, \$15,000 was set aside for new ministries. This money wasn't set aside for anything specific but rather to be used as the Holy Spirit led (and placed back in the bank if it is not used). If you have an idea for a new ministry or project at Redeemer, we want to hear about it.
- A second motion was approved to set aside \$35,000 for Endowed Scholarship fund. While the details haven't been worked out, our hope is to start a fund that will go to a local high-schooler (not necessarily a Redeemer member) for college. Since it's an endowment, it would

re-occur year after year without losing the initial investment.

Finally, we do want the congregation to know about next steps.

- After what was approved, there is still \$200,000 left in the original anonymous gift we received. Our hope is to present plans for that at our next congregational meeting (January 2018). While nothing is official, it is safe to say that several of us are looking at taking on the children's wing with the bulk of this money.
- The vote on the endowed scholarship was close 36-32. In discussion with several members who voted "no", it's important to point out that they were not against a scholarship per se, but rather felt money should have been given away immediately rather than kept in a bank. As the new council meets this summer, I'm sure a discussion will take place regarding whether or not to have a follow-up meeting with the congregation this fall. We will keep you posted.




