By now, most of you have seen (and participated in!) our "This is Us" project for the new year – sharing our prayer requests for 2018. I want to say thank you to all who shared and I am excited to learn about where you see God working in your lives. Each week, I take time on Friday to pray for all the requests and I know others do, too. I am confident that we will see God move as we lift up our needs to Him.

There's now a challenge in front of us as a church: Because the board is full, it is incredibly tempting to think "We're done". But this is only the beginning! I want to encourage everyone to continue with this prayer project by taking three specific steps:

We'll be sharing a new project in April. I hope you'll jump in with us. But let's not give up on this project either! Keep sharing your requests and praying for others. I'm hungry to see God reap a harvest here at Redeemer!!

praising God. I have 5 self-produced CD's of mostly original music. I also sing/play piano in a couple of DFW bands. I also love health and fitness and am a long-time certified personal trainer and group instructor.



Spending Approved

At the **Special Congregational Meeting** held on **Sunday, February 25, 2018**, Redeemer members unanimously approved Council's motion to spend up to \$80,000 of the unallocated \$200,000 (still remaining from the \$350,000 undesignated gift) for the replacement of our rusting steel windows (sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, and offices).

Council hopes to discuss the plan for the remaining unallocated \$120,000 at the upcoming June meeting.

March Sermon Series: “Instrument and Object”

This is a verse-by-verse study of the book of 1 John. The idea is that God is always working ON us, even as He works THROUGH us. As Redeemer works to share the Gospel in our community, we ourselves should be growing closer to God.
