# The Master's Touch

## From the Pastor's Desk

*"Go up and take possession of the land I have given you." But you rebelled against the command of the Lord your God. You did not trust Him or obey Him. (Deuteronomy 9:23)*

I left the conference feeling like I had been punched in the gut. I didn't know whether to celebrate because God had revealed something that was holding me back from His will or to mourn because that same revelation exposed my sin. Either way, I still can't escape the revelation even though time has now passed since the conference.

I was just finishing up a racial justice conference in Austin. The speaker was going to close his presentation by outlining practical steps churches could take to engage in racial justice. But at this point the speaker paused, forgot about the topic for a moment, and shared his heart. He told us if we really wanted to, we could probably brainstorm 7-10 good ideas in just a few moments. He continued by pointing out that in his experience, most churches don't fail in racial justice because of a lack of ideas. Instead, it was a lack of willingness to take bold steps. Rather than giving us ideas for next steps forward, he concluded the conference by warning us

not to let our "lack of ideas" become a convenient excuse to evade the fact that we are simply unwilling to obey the Lord.

As I said, it was a gut punch. The more I reflect on it, it's a gut punch that goes well beyond race relations. How often do "lack of ideas" or "lack of next steps" become a way to rationalize the feeling that deep down, we simply do not want to obey the Lord?

As we reflect upon the Easter season and the power of the resurrection, I think this conference speaker has given us all an important word. The difficulty in following Jesus is not from a lack of creativity. It is almost always an unwillingness to obey. And the joy of following (and seeing!) Jesus won't be found until we learn to trust and obey. Take some time this April to pray over your life in light of the resurrection. Is there a situation you face where you simply need a willing heart instead of one more idea?

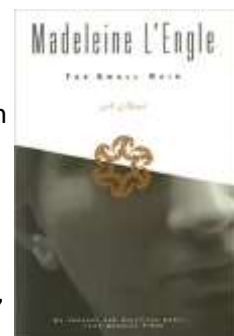


## Book Club
