# From the Pastor's Desk

When Herod realized that he had been outwitted by the Magi, he was furious, and he gave orders to kill all the boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity who were two years old and under... (Matthew 2:16)

It would be wise of Redeemer to not let me plan the children's Christmas pageant. There are multiple reasons why I would not be qualified to do so, but one in particular stands out as we wrap up December and begin a new year: I have issues with the content of the pageant. All of the Christmas plays I have been to have neglected a key "Christmas" story. That story is when Mary & Joseph must flee to Egypt due to Herod's rage. In his paranoiac jealousy, Herod has the boys of Bethlehem killed. It is commonly called the "Massacre of the Innocents."

I have never seen it enacted in a children's play. And the logic is sound. Can anyone imagine the following announcement at church: "For this year's Christmas pageant supplies, we will need two sheep costumes and 36 bottles of ketchup for the fake blood!"?

Every year there is that one Sunday which comes after Christmas but before the new year begins in which this story is told. As we start to spend our gift cards and finish the leftover desserts, we are separated from the mourning and devastation of innocent children killed by a jealous

madman. How did the moms and dads feel? Did they blame Herod? Or maybe they blamed the foreigners (Magi) who disturbed their uneasy truce with Herod? Did they harbor resentment toward Mary & Joseph, whose child was protected? Would they be aghast at the way we celebrate the events today that triggered their heartbreak?

I do not have good answers to the Massacre of the Innocents. All I have settled on is that Jesus' introduction to the world was disruptive. His birth is not a nice, genteel, Christmas pageant, suitable for all ages. Jesus' life may (should?) make for me some enemies of this world. His life may stoke some of my own insecurities and jealousies which I'd rather see ignored. The Massacre of the Innocents teaches me that I must be prepared for my world to be disrupted by Jesus' life.

I will not take charge of the children's Christmas pageant, so don't worry! But let me ask you this: What if Jesus' introduction to our world is good, but not peaceful? What if Jesus' work in my life in 2020 will be good but not peaceful? How will I respond? I think asking that question is what makes this neglected story so important.


